

MISSIONS OUTREACH IN THAILAND

The following letter is from Kiatisak Siripanadorn, coordinator of the work in northern Thailand. He has translated Pastor Achong Ayi's report of his activities among the Akha tribe in extreme northern part of Thailand. Remember these men and their families in your prayers.

Dear Brother Glenn,

Thank you so much for sending me email and I am very sorry for my delay write back to you. First, I would like to give thank to you and your Revival Crusade ministry for your great part in the ministry in Thailand among the Akha tribe. I am really appreciated your love to them and also thank you for praying for me for many activities that I am jumping into any areas that the Lord open for me to bring the Gospel to the people. I was in Mandaley, Myanmar last week of Nov- First week of December with my church member his mother has a coffee company there. She has introduced her Chinese-Myanmar pastor to me over a year, so we have met each other and his name is Paulo U Tun Kyi as my age. Pastor Paulo is pastor of Chinese church in Mandaley as independent church and he took us for survey to many town and villages and to the area that very close to China too but we need to come back to sleep at Mandaley. You may know that the foreigner missionary will not allow to do any gospel ministry in the country. That is true. But I have another idea as Pastor Paulo has share with me as I am Asian I could do the training the people, Teach and preach as long as I work as the team with them. The more I know what we can do, so I really praying that the Lord will open the way for me to help this pastor friend to do more ministries among his Burmese, Chinese and to go to the border of China too.

Here is the report from Pastor Achong Ayi at Cat's eye Akha BC. I got his report in very two month then when the report completed for four months. I will reread again from those four months and what happened with the ministry that he is doing. Last two years. I took Pastor Phil, Pastor Dan, Pastor Melvin Brindley and the group visited Pastor Achong and the church.

Here is his report from September-December 2009.

1. He has been to evangelized two new villages and follows up these two places.
2. They are 7 of them accepted the Lord. And 4 of them followed the Lord into water baptism.
3. I did receiving support every month from Revival Crusade through Grace Baptist Church Association.
4. Weekly Bible study at the church at night. Every night they about 25-35 came to bible study. Today, they are about 55-60 of them join in bible study.

5. Sunday worship service. They are about between 70-80 came to the church in the morning and evening.

6. Thanks and prayer requests:

1. Thank you so much for Revival Crusade for your part serving the Lord at Cat's eye Akha BC. I am growing in knowledge with my serving the Lord and do His will at my home church. To be a full time pastor is big difference than to be helping pastor. Thank you Revival Crusade for supporting me that I could serve Him better today. Pray for me and my family.

2. We have sending 3 of our church members to Bible College in Bangkok. One of them is my sister. Hoping that these 3 will come back to Cat's eye and help more Akha people come to know the Lord and help Akha believers grow up in God's word.

3. Pray for February 2, Pastor Kiatisak will bring the Medication team come to the village. This is our opportunity to get the people come to see the doctors for medication and Preach to them. Pray that will be many people will come and come to know the Lord.
